Act as CHL's program representative, leading interaction with the State Government, advisors and program partners ensuring strong relationships and effective communication strategies. Lead the internal governance processes making sound recommendation to the executive and the CHL board. Implement and manage an ongoing reporting and performance monitoring regime including close attention to program risk management Oversee program finance and budgeting ensuring compliance obligations with our lenders and State Government are met. Support the development team to identify new project opportunities, building relationships with long term partners who can provide ongoing project opportunities aligned with CHL"s strategic objectives.
