OBJECTIVE OF THIS ROLE

Be responsible to the Water and Sewer Supervisor to efficiently and reliably operate and maintain the water and sewerage treatment plants and associated infrastructure in Cloncurry, including Dajarra and Kajabbi.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES IN THIS ROLE

The following outlines the general duties and responsibilities of the position, but is not all encompassing:

- Monitor, operate and maintain the sewerage, water treatment plants, pumps, equipment and assets;
- Record daily results of flow meter, electric meter, plant and equipment hour meters;
- Be familiar with the operation of both the water and sewerage treatment plants and perform tasks associated with the operation of the plant as rostered and as requested by the team leader;
- Collect and record daily water and waste/water samples as required;



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- Calibrate dosing pumps and adjust dosing rates in accordance to test results;
- · Record any other test results as directed by supervisor;
- Monitor and record chemical usage and carry out stocktakes as required;
- Collate and provide information on performance, including but not limited to flow rates, quality or other issues;
- Organise and work with other external contractors as required;
- Recommend improvements to the system as identified that would facilitate better services to the residents of Cloncurry Shire or would improve efficiency and reduce costs within the area of responsibility or other areas of Council's operations;
- Assist with maintenance and repairs to water and sewer infrastructure as required;
- Perform weekend work as rostered for planned 40 hour week;
- Other duties as reasonably expected within the scope of the position.

ABILITIES, SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED

- Have extensive knowledge and experience in the operation and maintenance of water and sewerage treatment plants and associated infrastructure.
- Demonstrated problem solving skills with the ability to make accurate, on the spot decisions;
- Demonstrated communication and interpersonal skills;
- · Have effective time management skills;
- Demonstrated literacy and numeracy skills;
- Demonstrated ability to work independently with minimal supervision and perform well within the immediate work team and across Council as a whole;
- · Be familiar with Drinking Water Quality Management Guidelines
- Have, or can quickly acquire, extensive knowledge of Workplace Health & Safety and it application in the workplace.

QUALIFICATIONS, EDUCATION AND LICENCES REQUIRED

- Mandatory Certificate III in Water Treatment Plant Operations
 - (a minimum of 5 years' experience with water treatment)
- Must hold and maintain an unrestricted "C" Class driver's licence;
- Must have or acquire before commencement a Construction White Card;
- · Possess Confined Spaces Certification (or the ability to acquire);
- Possess Chlorine Safety Training Certification (or the ability to acquire);
- Possess High risk forklift ticket (or the ability to acquire);
- Certificate IV in Water Treatment Plant Operations (Highly Desirable)
