Introduction

We are seeking dynamic and passionate coaches to join the St Catherine's Netball Club to lead our players to achieve their full potential. The ideal candidate will possess a strong background in netball, a commitment to athlete development and coaching, and the ability to foster a positive and competitive team environment.

Specific Responsibilities

- Lead a team of players through their training and matches. This includes the planning of engaging training sessions that challenge players to develop their skills and game sense, as well as developing and teaching match strategies.
- Promote and role model the values of fair play and sportsmanship.
- Ensure that players uphold the St Catherine's Netball Club codes of conduct.
- Ensure that the St Catherine's Netball Club policies regarding match day processes and team selection are followed.
- Assist with team selection processes.
- Track attendance at training and matches.
- Track team strengths and weaknesses and design coaching strategies to compliment these.

Child Safety Responsibilities

- Provide students with a Child Safe environment.
- Ensure and promote the safety of children from diverse backgrounds including children from culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds, Aboriginal children, and children with disabilities.
- Be familiar with and comply with the School's Child Safe policy and Child Safe Code of Conduct, and any other policies or procedures relating to child safety.
- Participate in the School's Child Safe training programs as required.
- Raise any child safety concerns with the School's Child Safety Champions.

Occupational Health and Safety Responsibilities

- Comply with Victorian OHS legislation and the School's OHS policies and procedures.
- Perform duties in a safe manner without risk to their own health and safety, or the health and safety of others including, but not limited to students, other staff, contractors, volunteers, and visitors.

- An understanding of and commitment to implementing the St Catherine's coaching style and the Netball Australia Skills Development framework.
- Available for training sessions in Toorak, 6.45am-8am on Friday mornings during term time.
- Available for matches in Malvern East on Tuesday evenings and/or Saturdays during term time.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and capacity to relate well to teenage girls.
- High level communication skills.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and the capacity to establish a good rapport with students, parents and colleagues.
- Ability to work and contribute to a team situation.
- Ability to be proactive and take initiative.
