- A demonstrated willingness to become actively involved in the College's co-curricular program and all aspects of College life.
- A demonstrated commitment to child safety and the protection of every child from harm.
- An active involvement in a Protestant Christian Church.

## **Duties**

- Teach across year levels and learning areas as required
- Assume responsibility for the development of a quality learning environment for students including effective lesson planning and documentation
- Ensure teaching and learning environment and teaching programs reflects a Christian worldview
- Prepare quality and relevant assessment tasks
- Develop and maintain accurate and detailed formative and summative evaluative records for all students including portfolios
- Prepare student reports within College guidelines
- Where required develop Individual Learning Plans
- Leave work for classes when on leave or professional development
- Active involvement in developing and maintaining partnerships with parents
- Communicate regularly with parents on matters of student welfare and progress
- Attend all staff, sub-school and curriculum meetings
- Be present at College Chapel service, when on duty at that time
- Actively participate in co-curricular activities including camps, sporting activities and other aspects of College life
- Accept responsibility for the behaviour outside the classroom of all students, not only those taught
- Carry out allocated duties such as yard duty or other allocated duties
- Actively pursue professional development opportunities which enhance classroom practice and contribute to ongoing VIT registration.

- Be actively involved in the College's pastoral care program
