The Project Manager is responsible for the planning, execution, and delivery of infrastructure and capital works projects across the Cloncurry Shire region. This role ensures projects are delivered on time, within budget, and to the required quality standards, while complying with council policies, regulations, and community expectations.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead and manage multiple infrastructure projects from initiation to completion.
- Develop project plans, budgets, timelines, and risk assessments.
- Coordinate internal teams, contractors, consultants, and stakeholders.
- Monitor project progress and prepare regular reports for senior management.
- Ensure compliance with WHS, environmental, and procurement regulations.
- Engage with community members and stakeholders to ensure transparency and responsiveness.
- Manage contract Delays, variations, and Quality.
- Identify opportunities for process improvement and cost efficiency.
