## **POSITION OBJECTIVES**

The Laboratory Technicians support the Science teaching teams to ensure the smooth operation and delivery of the Science curriculum which includes ensuring all practical requirements are met in an organised and timely fashion and that Laboratories and science equipment are well maintained.

Laboratory support	<ul> <li>Procurement of resources as required by the teaching and learning programs</li> <li>Regular maintenance of laboratory equipment</li> <li>Ensure preparation of chemicals, experiments, etc. are performed in accordance with current relevant regulations and information outlined in Material Safety Data sheets and Risk Assessment guides.</li> <li>Prepare materials, stock and standard solutions, specimens and apparatus as required by the Science programs</li> <li>Assist with the planning, setting up and testing of methods/ demonstrations/ experiments ensuring they function correctly</li> <li>Assist teachers in planning, developing and refining Scientific demonstrations/ experiments/ simulations</li> <li>Collection and clean-up of equipment following the conclusion of science practical classes</li> <li>Adopting safe disposal of biological and chemical residues and waste in accordance with Victorian Government regulations</li> <li>Ensure laboratories are kept clean, tidy and clutter free at all times including regular testing of safety equipment such as eye wash and safety showers</li> <li>Maintain adequate stocks of equipment and chemicals to facilitate efficiency when practicals are requested</li> <li>Ensure Material Safety Data Sheets and the Hazardous Substances Register is maintained and up to date at all times according to government regulations</li> <li>Maintain an accurate record of purchasing data for budgeting purposes</li> <li>Other incidental duties such as special orders, emails, making bookings etc. required to facilitate the teaching and learning programs as directed by the Faculty Head of Science when needed</li> <li>Ensure Laboratory preparation areas are well maintained, clutter free and compliant with OHS regulations</li> </ul>
