WHAT DOES THE ROLE DO:	<p>Under supervision, the Apprentice Bricklayer will:</p> <p>Bricklaying & Construction Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Measure, cut and lay bricks and blocks, construct straight and curved walls, piers, steps, corners and openings. • Assist with basic set-out, levelling and measuring • Install flashings and damp-proof courses • Support general masonry prep and clean-up <p>Tools, Equipment & Plan Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read and interpret plans, drawings and specifications. • Use masonry hand tools and power tools. • Work on restricted-height scaffolding in line with WHS requirements. <p>Worksite Conduct & Safety</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain a clean and safe work area. • Follow WHS procedures, PPE requirements and supervisor instructions • Assist with general site labouring as required
