WHAT DOES THE ROLE DO:	<p>Under supervision, the Apprentice Plumber will:</p> <p>Roof Plumbing Installation & Maintenance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Install, repair and maintain metal roofing, cladding and rainwater systems. • Assist with installation of gutters, downpipes, flashings and roof penetrations. • Carry out basic waterproofing tasks related to roofing systems. • Support senior roof plumbers with roof inspections, leak detection and maintenance work. • Perform basic testing, measurements and checks to ensure correct installation. <p>Tools, Plans & Calculations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read and interpret roofing plans, site drawings and work instructions. • Take accurate measurements, set out roof components and perform simple calculations. • Safely use hand tools, power tools and equipment specific to roof plumbing (snips, nibblers, riveters, drills, ladders, harnesses). <p>Site Conduct & Safety</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow WHS procedures, fall-prevention requirements and PPE standards. • Participate in toolbox talks, risk assessments and safe work method statements. • Maintain clean, organised and safe work areas, including roof access points. • Complete training records, workplace documentation and apprenticeship requirements.
