Position Details

Purpose of the role

To be a proactive worker within the Science Faculty team of the College and provide support to the Secondary Science programme.

About the position

The successful applicant will work with the Science faculty where the main role is to provide expertise in preparing practical experiments and activities to ensure the smooth running of the practical science curricular requirements.

This role sits within the Secondary Campus, and will work across a number of areas within the science team, where the staff member will:

- Be responsible for the setup, cleaning of equipment and packing away of science experiments and hands-on activities, including preparation of chemical solutions and their safe disposal
- At the request of teaching staff, assist students with experiments embedded in the Physics, Biology and Chemistry curricula, as well as the Junior Science curriculum
- Assist in the ordering and management of stock and consumables within the constraints of the budget of the science department
- Assist in keeping the science laboratories clean and functioning, and assist with workplace health and safety audits in those spaces
- Support the development and rollout of various applications and programs across the College, to make College operations more efficient and user-friendly
- Attend external training events and seminars relevant to this position to maintain currency of information with contemporary practises and procedures
- Other administrative tasks as assigned, to assist teaching delivery and the strength of the Science Department

This position will report to the Science Instructional Dean, with overall management from the Head of Secondary.

What we are looking for:

Highly desirable skills and attributes for this position are:

- A science degree, Diploma of Laboratory Technology or Certificate IV in Laboratory Techniques
- Experience working as a laboratory technician

Other skills and attributes desirable for this position are:

- An interest in science and a passion for working with young people
- Attention to detail, to be precise in measurements and the ability to follow detailed instructions left by classroom teachers
- Experience in stock management and inventory, to make sure the laboratories are ready for all scheduled practicums
- A knowledge of workplace health and safety protocols when working with chemicals to ensure teaching can happen safely

Applicants must have a practising Christian faith and be actively involved in a church.
