Position Details

Purpose of the role

To give excellent customer service to College staff and students through expertise in operating various audio visual and multimedia equipment to support the delivery of Creative Industries subjects (Music, Art, Dance, Drama, Film and Television) as well as College functions and events.

About the position

This is a new position within the College to specialise in operation of audio visual equipment installed in the Creative Industries Precinct (CIP) building. The position will be the contact person for all College events using the CIP as well as supporting the maintenance and upkeep of these resources. Please note that **this position** may be required to work at a number of evening functions across the year.

This role sits within the Secondary campus, based in the Creative Industries Precinct, and will work across a number of areas within the team, where duties will include:

- Responsibility for the setup and pack-down of equipment used at events held in the CIP to ensure
 equipment is properly and safely used and ready for the next user, including;
 - o audio equipment (microphones, instruments, speakers)
 - o video presentation (projection, computer presentation software)
 - o video camera equipment (video camera, communications, video editing software)
 - other event support (audience seating, ticketing, signage, etc)
- Assistance in completing workplace health and safety tasks and audits to keep the CIP building safe for all users

This position will be active within the College facilities and at times will be required to adjust lighting rigs and move staging or other heavy items.

This position will report to the Head of Secondary but take day-to-day direction from the Creative Industries Instructional Dean and liaise closely with the Creative Industries teaching staff.

Hours for this position will be flexible, rostered monthly to work in with College events and schedules. The final hours will be discussed further with the successful applicant but will include some evenings to assist with College productions, music evenings, Open Nights and College meetings or other functions.

What we are looking for:

The following skills and attributes are desired for this position:

- Able to work both as part of a team but also independently with a maturity to complete set tasks without constant supervision
- Confidence and a willingness to learn technical elements of the role
- Experience in operating a sound desk, mixing sound inputs to ensure a well-balanced sound for an audience
- Experience in operating a video camera and filming live events
- · Excellent interpersonal skills, with experience training others in using audio visual equipment
- Knowledge or familiarity with health and safety requirements in a creative industries environment
- Ability to troubleshoot AV issues to ensure smooth running of all resources
- A level of physical fitness to complete tasks including changing stage lights, assisting with cable installations and/or shifting furniture and setting up chairs
- A real passion and interest in the creative, visual and performing arts and a desire to help young people grow in these areas

Applicants must have a practising Christian faith and be actively involved in a church.
