Purpose of the role

To manage and lead teaching and learning within our Primary School.

About the position

At Westside Christian College, we believe that every child is a special creation of God. This position is a permanent position commencing Term 1 2020 and is based on our Primary Campus.

The primary responsibilities of this position are:

- to advance the ongoing implementation of our Pedagogical and Curriculum Framework that influences our whole College approach to teaching and learning;
- to assist in managing a systematic approach in reviewing the quality of planning, teaching and learning, resources, assessment and reporting practices within P-6;
- to monitor student learning and achievement, using data including NAPLAN results, to inform changes to planning and teaching practices, and improve overall student learning outcomes;
- to manage and lead Primary Curriculum teams across P-6 and to incorporate data driven best practices and innovative learning methods;
- to facilitate intentional curriculum conversations between Junior and Senior Primary and Senior Primary with Junior Secondary years;
- to provide and/or organise professional learning for Primary staff in the strategic priority areas;

What we are looking for:

At Westside, we believe that great teachers are the cornerstone to the success of our students. Applicants must hold a current teaching registration through the Queensland College of Teachers as at the start of the 2020 school year.

Ideally, we are looking for someone with experience in a similar position, or who has committed time mapping curriculum through Primary year levels as well as into Secondary studies.
