Genazzano FCJ College is a high performing Catholic day and boarding school beginning with the Early Learning Centre (co-educational 3 and 4-year-old kindergarten) and girls only education from Preparatory to Year 12.

EXPECTATIONS OF STAFF IN A CHILD SAFE SCHOOL

POSITION PURPOSE

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

In accordance with the College Strategic Plan and instructions from the Director of Music, the Music Tutor is expected to:

- Teach private students and prepare and present students for recitals, competitions, Master Classes, examinations, VCE examinations and tertiary entrance auditions where applicable
- Organising, coordinating and supervising of examinations where applicable
- Have the capacity to accompany ensembles and instrumental students from beginners to advanced levels
- Develop a positive relationship with all students, from all levels throughout the College, which will engender a willingness to take part in our extensive music program
- Assist at concerts, recitals, workshops and music camps as required
- Be available to students and parents to discuss student progress and to build a positive and supportive relationship

- Communicate regarding scheduled rehearsals with students, instrumental teachers and parents in a clear manner
- Prepare and present performance opportunities for students
- Write reports for students
- Attend Music Department meetings as required
- Organisation of Musical items as requested
- Ordering of books
- Organisation of concerts and competitions in consultation with Director of Music
- Have the ability to work as a member of a team with an understanding of and interest in the total music program

KEY SELECTION CRITERIA

- A current Working with Children Check and Police Check are mandatory
- Tripple Covid vaccinated
- A high level of professional proficiency in performance
- Demonstrated high quality teaching skills which enable students to reach their full potential
- Commitment to a quality music program
- Demonstrated willingness to support the ethos of Genazzano FCJ College; including an active commitment to the College Mission and Vision

ACCOUNTABILITY & EXTENT OF AUTHORITY

- The Music Tutor is accountable to the Principal through the Director of Music who reports to the Principal
- For implementation of Child Safe Standards, this position is accountable to the Deputy Principal, Community and Connection – Child Safe Officer
- The position must ensure that it operates in accordance with the specific objectives, policies and strategies determined for the effective management of the College's resources and ensure decisions made by the position are subject to review by the Director of Music
