Purpose of the role

To provide quality musical instrument instruction to students.

About the position

This position provides instrumental music instruction to students from Years 4-12, for cello. The College operates across two campuses (closely situated) with Prep to Year 6 on one campus (open 8:45am - 2:40pm) and Year 7 to 12 on the other (open 8:30am - 2:50pm). The Instructor can consider ways to inspire students, and develop a thriving cello program within the College with a view to start up a cello ensemble.

The tutor will invoice the College on a weekly basis for all the lessons taught as per their timetable finalised at the start of term. The Instrumental Music Coordinator deals with the billing of students for lesson fees through the business office.

The Instructor will be able to choose his/her working days/hours in consultation with the College and current timetables established with students.

All these tasks should be undertaken within the Health and Safety policies and procedures established for the College, consistent with the Protestant, biblical basis of the College.

The position is for an Independent Contractor and the engagement is as such. As an independent contractor you may sub-contract others to complete your duties on your behalf, as you arrange with the College. This position reports to the College's Instrumental Music Co-ordinator, with overall supervision from the Head of Secondary.

Requirements of the position

While previous experience working with students in this role is desirable, it is not essential. Either way, you will need to demonstrate an aptitude for teaching students the cello.

Other requirements of this position are;

- Experience performing and teaching cello
- Technical proficiency on the cello
- Experience working with young children in individual and group lessons
- Confident teaching beginners through to more advanced students (Year 12)

Applicants must hold a current Blue Card or be eligible to obtain a Blue Card before commencing employment with the College. Applicants should be aware of the College's Statement of Faith and Staff Lifestyle Requirements available on the Application Form for this position, published on the College website.

The College reserves the right to perform additional qualification, criminal history or other relevant background checks as necessary to this position and you will be notified of any relevant checks if you are offered a position at the College.

Position hours and salary

The pay for this position can be discussed with our Instrumental Music Coordinator. As an independent contractor you are responsible for your own billing and other financial arrangements with the College.
