AIC Mines Limited (AIC) is a growth focused mining company. We are an ASX listed junior miner (A1M) focused on transformational growth via exploration, mergers and acquisition and operational excellence. We are guided by our values of safety, responsibility, delivery and transparency.

AIC recently acquired Demetallica Limited and therein the Jericho deposit which neighbours our Eloise Copper Mine. Eloise is an underground copper mine with conventional crushing and floatation that makes a high-quality copper concentrate. AIC intends on developing the Jericho deposit via the Jericho underground mine and an expansion of the Eloise processing plant and associated non-processing infrastructure. This compliments our portfolio of copper and gold exploration projects in Queensland, South Australia and Western Australia. We see a bright future for copper which will play a critical role in the transition to green energy.

About the Role:

The Mine Development Lead will head up the mining package of work for the Jericho Project sitting on the owners team and reporting directly to the Executive General Manager – Projects. The Jericho Project will develop an underground open stoping mining operation via single decline to produce and deliver 1-1.4mtpa to the Eloise processing plant via truck haul. Critical Infrastructure to be installed will be electrical and operational technology networks/backbones, dewatering system, ventilation, seismic system, water storage facilities and surface waste dump(s).

Key duties and responsibilities include:

- Updating optimised mine designs and schedules in Deswick
- Coordinate and finalise the Jericho underground mine study and design with technical team
- Update the Project Financial model and make decisions to maximise cash flow and capital efficiency for the Jericho Project
- Lead a mine contractor tender process and award mine development scope of work to successful contracting party
- Project management of mine development performed by contractor group(s) at Jericho involving early works, box cut, mining infrastructure sink and install, rapid development mining and mine related surface infrastructure
- Drive and ensure the health, safety, environment and people performance of contractor groups onsite
- Operational readiness and handover to mine production reporting to the SSE and UG Manager
- Commissioning of mining operations and mining infrastructure
- Assist with environmental design considerations for mining and infrastructure design. E.g., waste dumps, water storage.
