Position Purpose

Ensure the smooth operation, maintenance, installation and repair of machinery and equipment. This role ensures that all electrical work complies with relevant codes and standards, while minimising downtime and maintaining a high level of safety and efficiency

Key Accountabilities

- To perform the installation, repair and maintenance on all electrical plant and equipment to ensure the machinery and equipment is operating safely and efficiently.
- Assist in the installation and commissioning of new electrical systems and equipment according to specifications and safety standards.
- Maintain accurate records of maintenance activities, including logs of repairs and preventative maintenance tasks and report any potential issues or hazards to the Maintenance Electrical Coordinator or Maintenance Manager
- Participate in continuous improvement initiatives to enhance equipment reliability and performance and suggest and implement improvements to procedures.
- Work closely with production staff to minimise disruptions and downtime and communicate effectively with team members and other departments to ensure smooth operations.
- Adhere to all electrical standards, codes, health and safety requirements and maintain a clean and safe working environment

- Be a role model for working safely and promoting a safe working environment.
