Responsibilities

Boilermakers are part of the maintenance team responsible for planned & breakdown maintenance of infrastructure at Pilbara Ports.

Reporting

The Boilermaker reports to the Mechanical Supervisor East or Utah depending on location.

1.	Safety and People:	 Further a safe, inclusive, and collaborative workplace, that supports the mental health and wellbeing of self, and others. Identify actions and changes leading to continuous improvement of safe work environments; both physically and psychologically.
2.	Integrated Management Systems:	Assist in the development of systems that ensure Pilbara Ports complies with all applicable codes, as well as its legal and statutory requirements.
		 Comply with and demonstrate a positive commitment to organisational processes and ISO Management Systems including Quality, Environment, Safety and Information Security.
3.	Boilermaker / Welder Maintenance:	Undertake preventative maintenance, repairs and improvement programs as scheduled by either the Mechanical Supervisor, or maintenance planner.
		 Provide task supervision for any trades assistants and trainees/apprentices.
		 Undertake asset inspections and complete appropriate work requests for repair.
		 Complete associated paperwork required to ensure compliance to regulation, standards or Pilbara Ports procedures.
		 Provide input into the Computerised Maintenance Management System as required by the Mechanical Supervisor.
		 Provide a high level of workmanship and attention to detail with all fabrication works.
		Fabrication of fixed plant assets ranging from Electrical bracketry to transfer chutes.
4.	Other Duties:	Provide back up and support to the Mechanical Supervisor and Maintenance Superintendent when required.
		Other duties as requested by the Maintenance Superintendent.

Selection Criteria

Qualifications:

Qualifications in Heavy Fabrication or other metal trade with suitable post trade welding qualifications.

- Experience in industrial maintenance, preferably in a mining or port environment.

- Demonstrated understanding of maintenance programmes and schedules, safety responsibilities and procedures.
- Ability to plan, scope and execute tasks effectively in a high paced industrial environment.
- Demonstrated ability to work autonomously while managing time effectively to ensure work is completed in a timely manner.
- Good written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to work at heights, over water and within confined spaces.
