Boilermaker / Welder Maintenance:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undertake preventative maintenance, repairs and improvement programs as scheduled by either the Mechanical Supervisor, or maintenance planner. • Provide task supervision for any trades assistants and trainees/apprentices. • Undertake asset inspections and complete appropriate work requests for repair. • Complete associated paperwork required to ensure compliance to regulation, standards or Pilbara Ports procedures. • Provide input into the Computerised Maintenance Management System as required by the Mechanical Supervisor. • Provide a high level of workmanship and attention to detail with all fabrication works. • Fabrication of fixed plant assets ranging from Electrical bracketry to transfer chutes.
4. Other Duties:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide back up and support to the Mechanical Supervisor and Maintenance Superintendent when required. • Other duties as requested by the Maintenance Superintendent.

Selection Criteria

Qualifications:

Qualifications in Heavy Fabrication or other metal trade with suitable post trade welding qualifications.

Personal Attributes:

- Exhibit behaviours that align with Pilbara Ports' values of Safety, Excellence, Teamwork, Integrity, and Care.
- Demonstrated commitment to an inclusive work culture that encourages diversity.
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- Enjoy working in a dynamic environment where priorities and deadlines may change.

- Experience in industrial maintenance, preferably in a mining or port environment.
- Pre-Qualifications to AS1554.1 preferred
- Demonstrated understanding of maintenance programmes and schedules, safety responsibilities and procedures.
- Ability to plan, scope and execute tasks effectively in a high paced industrial environment.
- Demonstrated ability to work autonomously while managing time effectively to ensure work is completed in a timely manner.
- Good written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to work at heights, over water and within confined spaces.
