THE ROLE

To maintain a safe and supportive environment for young people to resolve crisis needs. In consultation with the team, the Youth Worker is also responsible for the development and implementation of strength-based, trauma informed support plans.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate under the YWCA Case Management, and Service Model and Practice Frameworks
- Develop and maintain strong and respectful relationships with clients, colleagues and external stakeholders including those from diverse cultural backgrounds and linguistic needs, to optimise service delivery and referral
- Work with the Case Manager, Youth Workers, and residents to develop programs and support plans that meet the individual needs of each resident
- Ensure a trauma informed approach when responding to challenging behaviours and maintain safety through effective response to potential or actual critical situations
- Maintain a safe and clean home environment
- Coach and support young people with basic independent living skills
- Maintain accurate client information and case notes on the client management system
- Be a part of a 24-hour roster, including sleep over and weekend shifts
- Attend regular supervision, staff meetings and training as required
- Other tasks as assigned
