THE CROSS RIVER RAIL PROJECT

Cross River Rail is a new 10.2km rail line including 5.9km of twin tunnels running under the Brisbane River and CBD that will unlock a bottleneck at the core of the rail network and will transform the way we travel across the whole of Southeast Queensland.

It will include four new underground stations – at Albert Street, Boggo Road, Roma Street and Woolloongabba - through the middle of Brisbane, provide new above-ground stations at the RNA Showgrounds and Dutton Park, upgrade six stations between Fairfield and Salisbury, deliver three new stations on the Gold Coast and introduce a new world-class signaling system to the wider SEQ rail network.

Once Cross River Rail is operational, journeys will be quicker, stations will be in more convenient locations and there will be capacity to increase train services as our population grows. Making public transport a more viable option for the whole region and helping to ease congestion on our roads.

ROLE OVERVIEW

The Senior Possessions Planner is responsible for coordinating the Cross River Rail track possessions including assessing and interrogating works programs to support Cross River Rail construction.

- Engage with Cross River Rail project teams and Queensland Rail to identify potential impacts to the track possessions program.
- Assess construction works programs to identify and document impacts associated with project works undertaken during track possessions.
- Monitor, identify and escalate key risks and issues related to the track possessions program and provide advice on solutions and mitigation measures.
- Engage with external stakeholders impacted by the track possessions program, ensuring application of appropriate governance frameworks.
- Develop and manage process and procedures, documents, and tools, ensuring compliance with project requirements, contractual obligations, and governance frameworks.
- Collate and update data sources to ensure information is up to date information and accurate for reporting metrics and to support the tracking of dependencies.
- Communicate upcoming possessions/track closures, track and monitor performance and report progress.
- Chair, provide secretariat support, or attend Possession related working groups and project meetings.
- To work in accordance with the Delivery Authority policies, procedures and safety requirements and demonstrate alignment with our values and behaviours
